

How to enter PROBE contests

PROBE contests for bulletin editors and public relations efforts are held on both the International and District levels. Although district contests are subject to their own rules, deadlines, etc., most are run in a similar fashion to the International contests and follow these guidelines.

Entries into the International contests are chosen from qualifying entries on the district level.

Recognized contests are:

- International contests
 - International Bulletin Contest (both HARDCOPY and ELECTRONIC)
 - The entries of each district HARDCOPY winner will be sent Lowell Shank for judging in the HARDCOPY IBC.
 - The entries of each district ELECTRONIC winner will be sent to John Elving for judging in the ELECTRONIC IBC.
 - Public Relations Officer of the Year (PROTY)
Two categories – single event and year-long
 - Contact District VP for Marketing & Public Relations and/or the PROBE VP for Marketing & Public Relations.
- District contests
 - Bulletin Editor of the Year (BETY) either HARDCOPY or ELECTRONIC
 - Contact PROBE District Contest Coordinator (see elsewhere in ADLIBS) or John Elving – leaderman@earthlink.net
 - Public Relations Officer of the Year (Encouraged for each district)
 - Contact District VP for Marketing & Public Relations

In any case, entries must be submitted through the PROBE coordinator for your district. Please contact him for deadlines applicable to your district and any further details that you may require. All entrants must be members of PROBE (a reasonable chapter expense – see application for in this publication.)
